POSITION SUMMARY

A Senior Engineer, under limited supervision, performs professional work of considerable difficulty in managing the design, construction, engineering and development, of flood control, roads, bridges, utilities and infrastructure projects for the Public Works Dept (PWD). Designs, plans, coordinates, and inspects PWD civil engineering projects; analyzes complex issues, develops recommendations and implements solutions. Performs drafting and computing work; checks and directs field operations involved in the gathering and compilation of field data for the design, layout and construction of roads, flood control, bridges, utilities, infrastructure and related projects. Makes structural and technical engineering analysis of proposed projects, evaluates need for design changes and makes appropriate recommendations. Inspects and monitors PWD project under contract; manages technical engineering databases; oversees contract administration for PWD projects; inspects construction projects to verify and enforce compliance to construction plans and quality standards. Duties may vary according to job assignment. This position is represented by the Teamsters Union Local 252, Supervisors Collective Bargaining Unit.
