## POSITION SUMMARY

Under general supervision, performs field inspections and investigations to enforce State and County codes and ordinances relating to public health and safety issues and public nuisances; investigates complaints and issues citations for code violations within scope of authority.

This position performs land use and environmental inspections to ensure safety and general welfare of County residents, enforces County codes encompassing vehicle abatement, nuisance abatement, and land use. Responds to complaints of potential code violations relating to environmental control, hazards, abandoned vehicles, and dumping. Initiates investigations and analysis based on preliminary information, contacts individuals to discuss violations.
