The Lewis County Civil Service Commission is accepting applications for Community Services Officer. Community Services Officers work in the Lewis County Sheriff's Office.

SALARY & BENEFITS

The current salary range is \$5,097 – \$6,853 (DOQ). See benefit document attached for full list of benefits. Community Services Officers participate in the Washington State Department of Retirement Systems and may elect to participate in deferred compensation plans. This is a Teamsters Local #252 union position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Citizen of the United States.
- Provide proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
- Read and write English.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Minimum 19 years of age.
- Washington State driver's license.
- Minimum keyboarding speed 30 words per minute (corrected).
- Passing score on panel interview.
- Pass physical assessment, polygraph and thorough background examination.
- Meet and pass State and Federal background and testing to be certified to access restricted and confidential computer systems.
